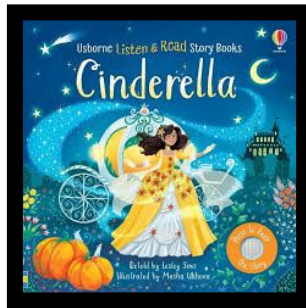


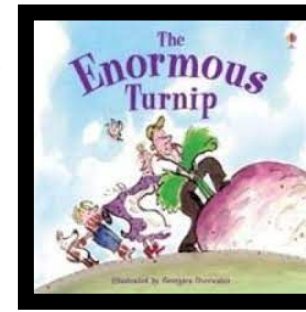

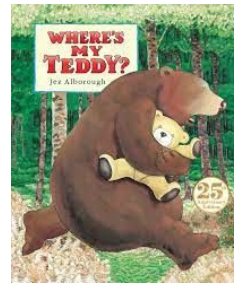


Communication, Language and Literacy

- Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.
- Learn new vocabulary.
- Ask questions to find out more and to check they understand what has been said to them.
- Articulate their ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences.
- Connect one idea or action to another using a range of connectives.
- Describe events in some detail.
- Use talk to help work out problems and organise thinking and activities, and to explain how things work and why they might happen.

Mathematics

- Count objects, actions and sounds.
 - Subitise.
- Link the number symbol (numeral) with its cardinal number value.
 - Compare numbers.
 - Explore the composition of numbers.
 - Explore pattern.

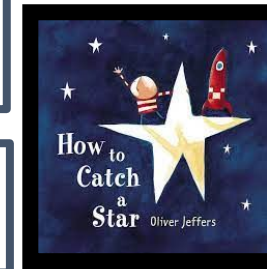


Our Literacy texts will be:

Understanding the World

- Talk about members of their immediate family and community.

Expressive Arts and Design

- To echo sing (matching a range of pitches and rhythms).
- To perform a range of songs with actions.
- To improvise ideas in story songs.
- To use the voice expressively (dynamics).

Phonics

- Read individual letters by saying the sounds for them.
- Blend sounds into words, so that they can read short words made up of known letter– sound correspondences.
- Form lower-case letters correctly.

Physical Development

- Develop overall body-strength, balance, coordination and agility through Gymnastics and Dance.
- Revise fundamental movements - including; rolling, crawling, walking, jumping, running, hopping, skipping, climbing.
