

One of our main aims this year is to help your children become much more





Children will also be able to borrow and return books during **break and lunch times**.

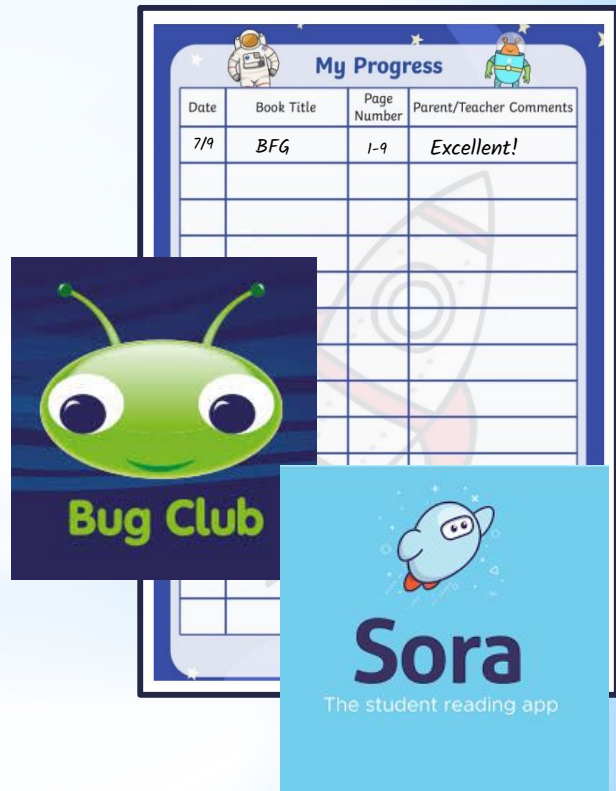


Homework

- **Homework** is given to the children on a **Friday** and handed in by **Wednesday**.
- All homework resources will be available on **Google Classroom**.
- Children should learn to **organise their time** and choose the best days for doing their homework.

Homework

- Reading should occur **3-5 times per week** and reading records signed - rewards are given for this.
- Children will also use Bug Club & SORA to support their reading skills.



Homework

- **Times tables** should also be practised regularly using **Times Tables Rockstars**.



- If your child is having any **difficulties completing homework** then they should let their teacher know **as soon as possible**. Please don't wait until the last day to do this.

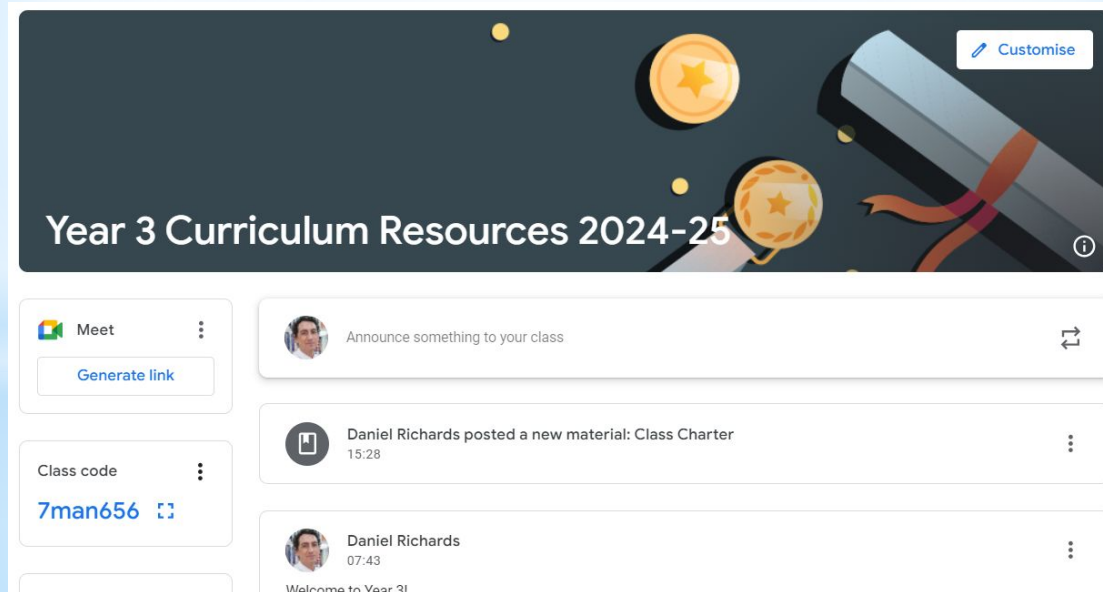


- **Google Classroom** - your child will be set **homework on Google Classroom**. They have their email address and password written in the front of their Home School diaries.
- Please allow them **access to an electronic device** to use this resource; the class teachers post resources throughout the year which will **consolidate learning**.

Each class in Year 3 has their own **Google Classroom page**. This page will allow teachers to share information and resources specifically to support their own class.

Final Points

All medication must be given directly to the **school nurse (Ms Cris)** with a **letter signed by the parent** explaining the illness and direction for administration of the medication.

ID Cards/Snack

Your child has been given an **ID card** which is also their library card.

This card is used to:

- Enter/exit the school building
- Borrow books from the school library
- Buy snacks and drinks once money is put on the card



Please ensure that children bring this ID card to school each day.
