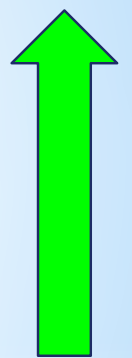
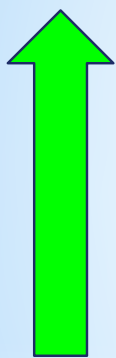

# Homework

There is a section in their Home School Diaries for them to write the words and they will also be posted on Google Classroom and written into their Homework Books.
