They record their homework in here but it can also be used to **communicate with class teachers**.

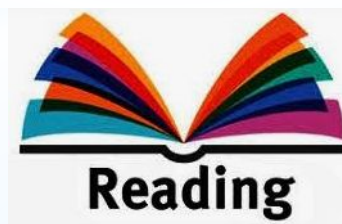
They also have Google Classroom accounts which they use in school and at home for resources.

Please encourage your children to check their Homework Diary regularly for their deadlines and timetables.

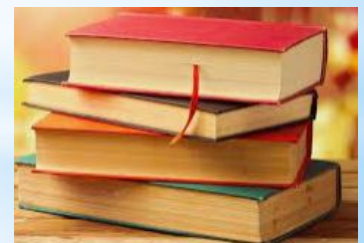
**Homework will usually be given Wednesday to Wednesday.** If this changes then your child's teacher will inform them.

# Homework

- **Homework** is given to the children each week for the core subjects with fair deadlines (usually Wednesday to Wednesday). We will also give Reading and Spelling homework each week.
- They record this in their Homework Diaries and it can be found on **Google Classroom** or will be given in physical form - not sure what to do? Always ask!
- Children should **organise their time** and choose the best days for doing their homework.

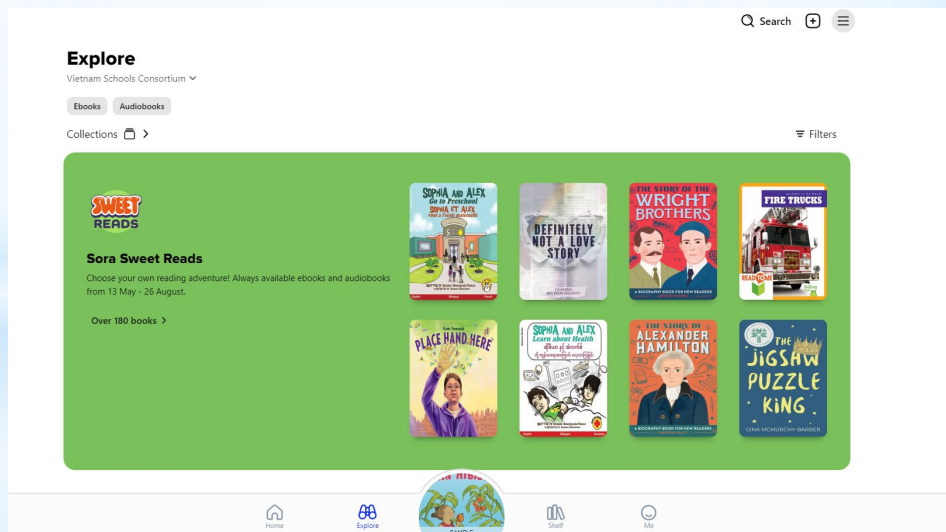


- We expect students to read 3-5 times a week at home. This may be physical books or through their Sora/ Bug Club account.
- In their homework diaries, students should note down the title and number of the page they read up to. They should write this every day that they read. Teachers will check this each week. For example- on Thursday Week 2: *The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe* Up to page 168.
- Children will also have a weekly Library slot to read and find new books.



# Sora

This year we have introduced our new online library, Sora. This an online platform that allows your child to access a range of books from a virtual library both at home and in school. 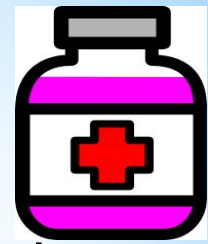
