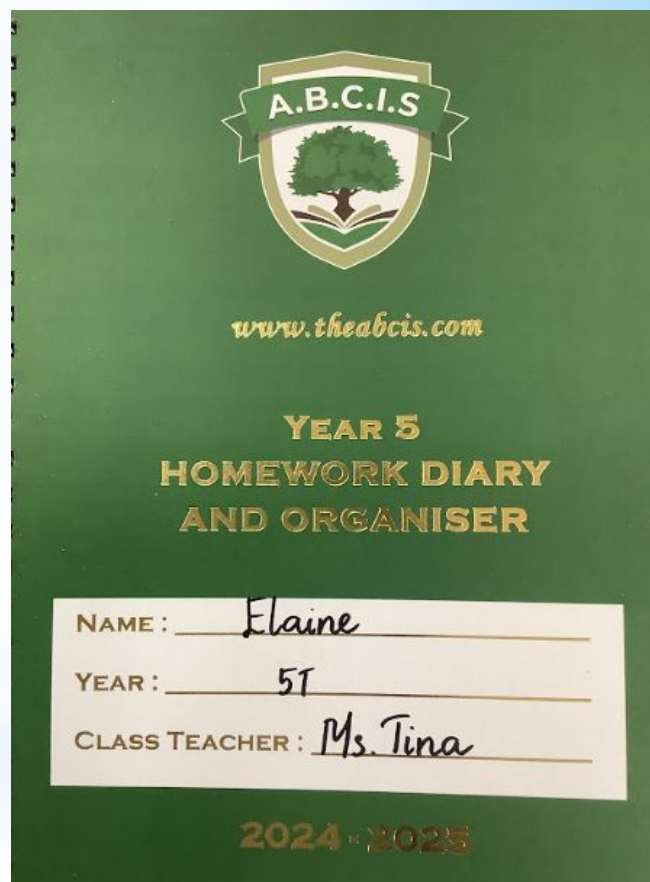
It is really important to us that the children are given opportunities to work in teams and to complete practical work. This will be a key focus this year.



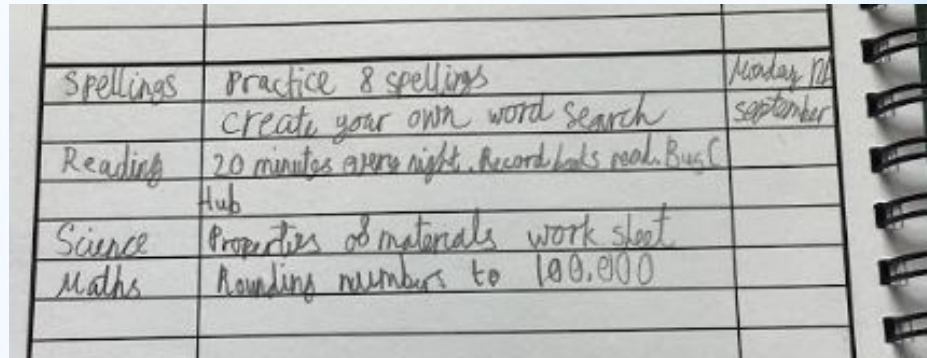
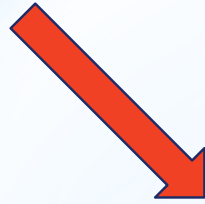
All of the Year 5 children now have their own **Homework diary.**

- **Times tables** should also be practised regularly using **Times Tables Rockstars**.

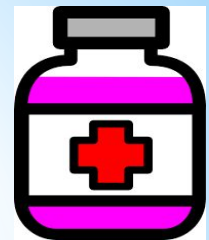


- If your child is having any **difficulties completing homework** then they should let their teacher know **as soon as possible**. Please don't wait until the last day to do this.

- Please allow them **access to a computer** to use this resource; the class teachers post resources throughout the year which will **consolidate learning**.

## Final Points
